

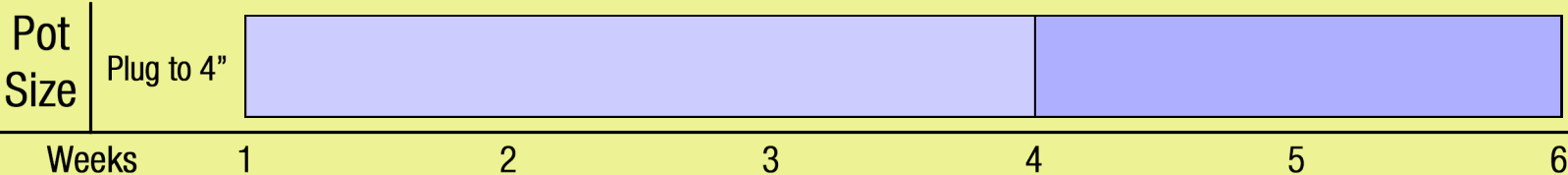


# Growing Recipe

# BEGONIA 'MARMADUKE'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 6.0 - 7.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.2 - 2.4

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

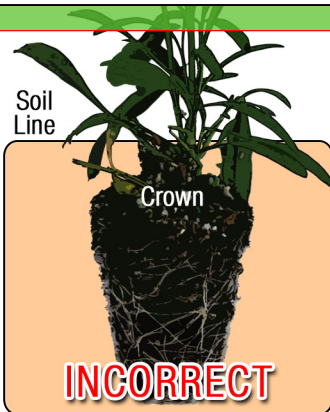
Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 10 - 11

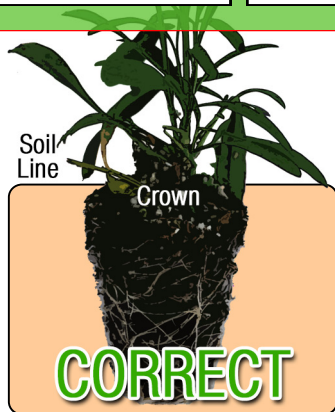
Possible Problems: Insect: Mealy bug if exposed  
Diseases: Powdery mildew is possible

Habit: Mounding

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug
