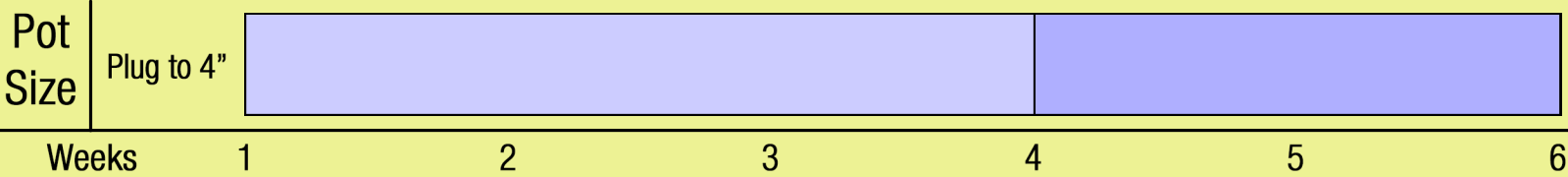


Growing Recipe

BEGONIA 'SILVER SPLENDOR'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 6.0 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.2 - 2.4

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

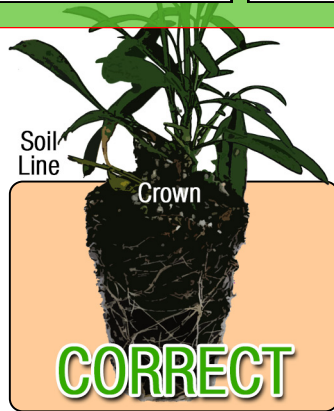
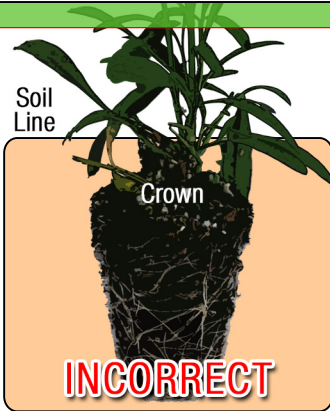
Hardiness Zones: 7 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Snails and slugs might be a problem in the garden

Habit: Upright

Diseases: Leaf spots may be a problem

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Bred by Dan Heims from hardy Chinese species, this upright begonia is unlike any other Begonia! Smooth, platinum splashed, palmate leaves, look like a silver leaf Japanese maple in the garden. Candy pink, heart-shaped flowers appear in late summer. Zone 7b hardy. American Begonia Society 'Distinctive hybrid' award in 2009.
