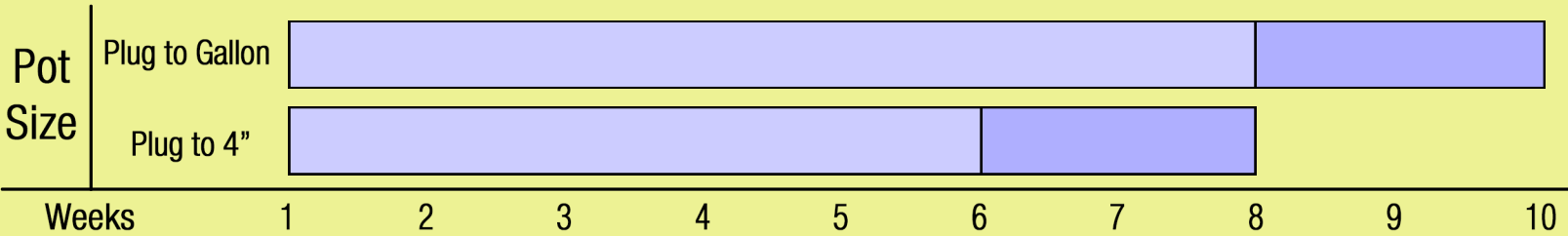

# CAMPANULA 'PANTALOONS'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun, tolerates part shade

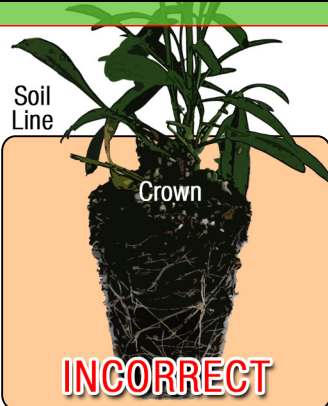
Water Requirements: Dry slightly to moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 9

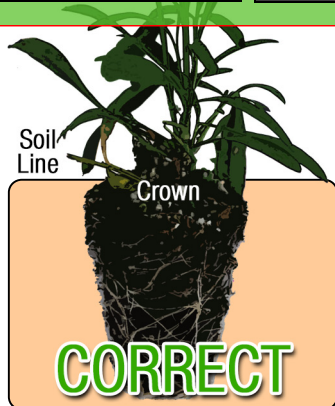
Habit: Vigorous, spreading by rhizomes

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, slugs & snails are all possible  
Diseases: Root rot, if they don't have good drainage

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

## Description

Impressive 2" light purple flowers that are shaped in a double 'hose-in-hose' configuration. Looks like an elaborate 1890's undergarment. (The plant will occasionally throw up single flowers.) This plant is vigorous and reaches standard C. punctata height.
