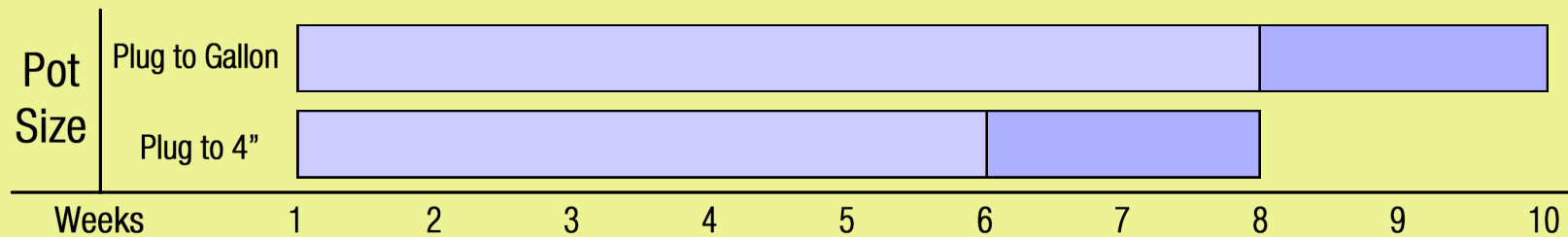


Growing Recipe

CAMPANULA 'PINK OCTOPUS'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

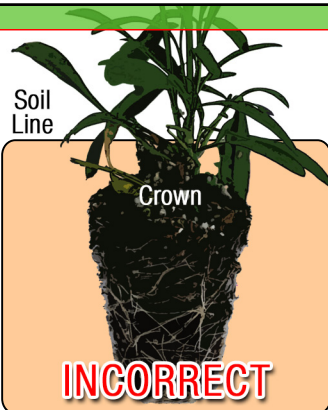
Hardiness Zones: 5 - 9

Habit: Compact mound, groundcover

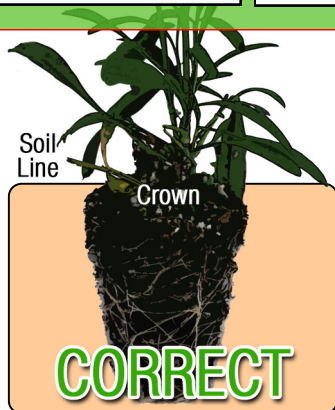
Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Water Requirements: Dry slightly to moderately between waterings

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, slugs & snails are all possible
Diseases: It will get root rot, if you don't have good drainage



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

Japanese lantern buds open to striking pink, octopus-like flowers. Over 50 blooms flutter down from the nicely upright flowering branches above strong, deeply cut foliage. Unique and interesting! Long bloom time and easy to grow. This spreader does very well in the South. Tolerant of most soils. Jimmy Turner, while at the Dallas Arboretum recommended this plant for green roofs. Vigorous!
