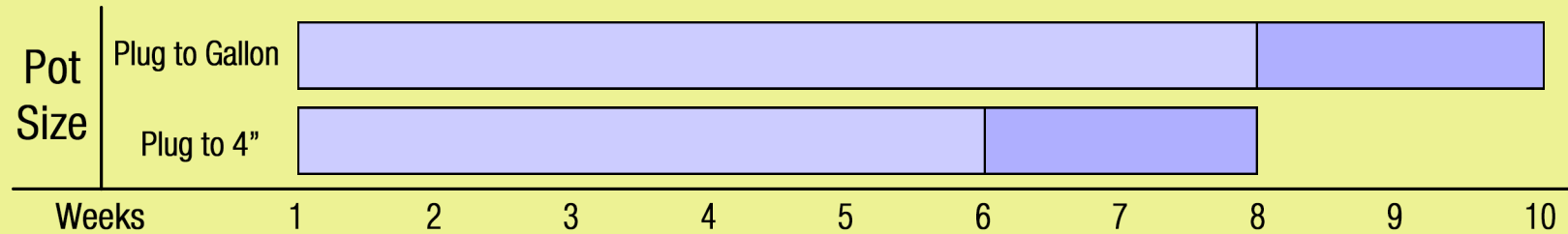


Growing Recipe

CISTUS 'MICKIE'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 6.5 - 8.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Allow to dry out between waterings

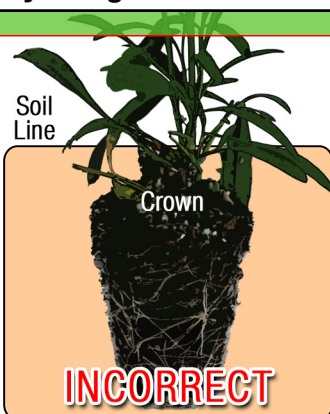
Hardiness Zones: 7 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: No major

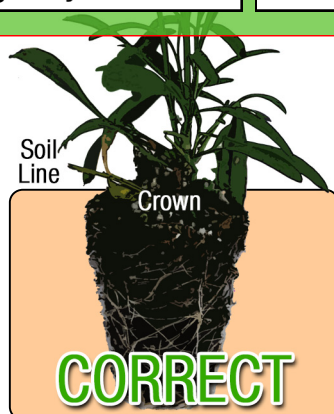
Habit: Mound

Diseases: No major. Cistus are very susceptible to root rot in wet soils.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

This stable variegated form of *Cistus hybridus* has a low, mounding habit that hugs the ground and creates a super colorful, evergreen colorspot. 'Mickie' hails from northern Washington State and has survived some brutal winters. Charming white flowers punctuate the flashy foliage in May and June. The Japanese use in mixed containers because of the fall pink leaf tints.
