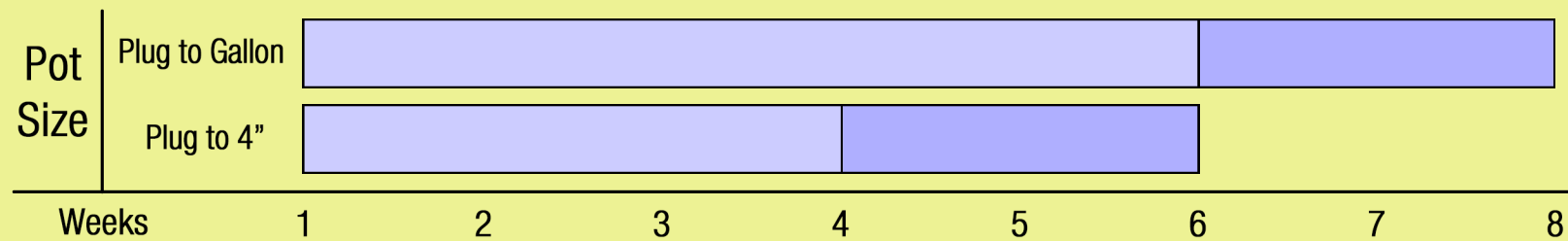


# Growing Recipe

# COREOPSIS 'CENTER STAGE'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.75 - 1.0

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: No major. Aphids, mites, white fly and thrips are possible.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: No major issues. Rust and powdery mildew are possible.

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

## Description

Bold magenta-red flowers cover this large, hardy, mounding Coreopsis. Hundreds of flowers appear early in the summer and continue until a hard frost in the fall. No deadheading is necessary. Each flower is covered by even more flowers as they fade. Needs good drainage. Coreopsis verticillata breeding makes this selection ultra-hardy.
