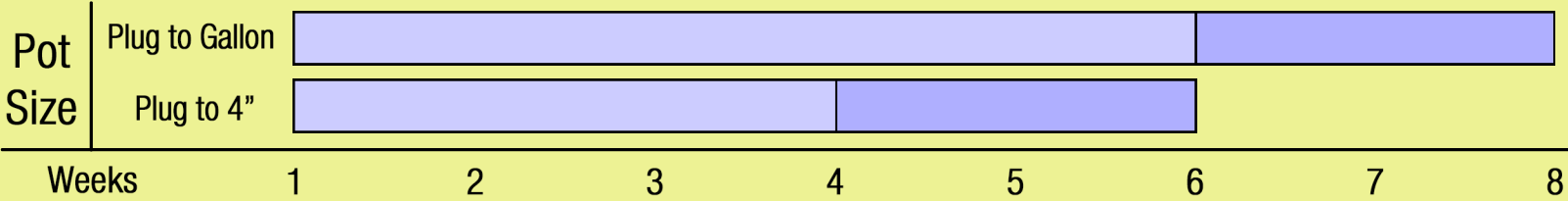


Growing Recipe

COREOPSIS 'FIREFLY'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.8 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

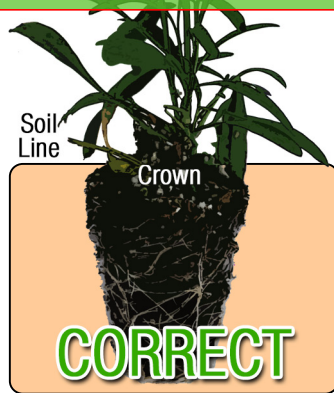
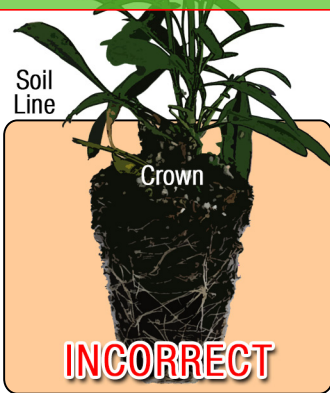
Hardiness Zones: 5 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: No major. Aphids, mites, white fly and thrips are possible.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Mildew is possible

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Description

Perfectly formed compact mounds of dense thread-like foliage are blanketed with startling, yellow and red bicolored flowers. Underneath the sheer beauty of this plant is the rock hardiness of *Coreopsis verticillata* breeding. Zone 5 hardy and super easy to grow with the added feature of powdery mildew resistance! This is definitely a plant for the front of the border or in a mixed container. Versatile, easy, and just fun!
