



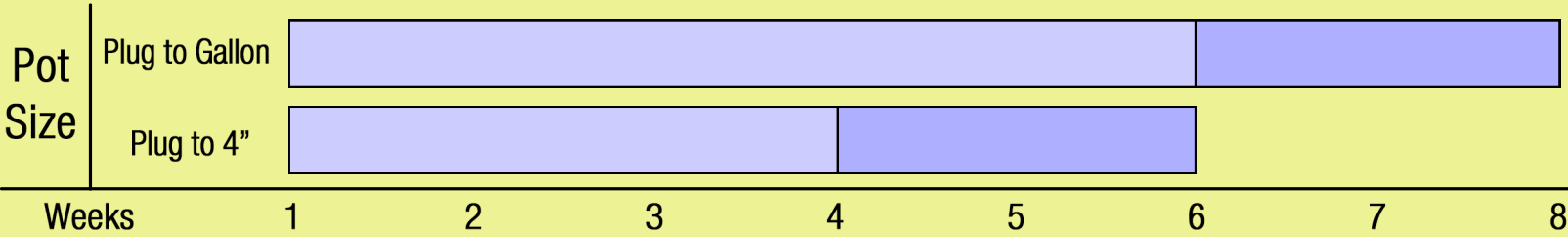

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.75 - 1.0

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

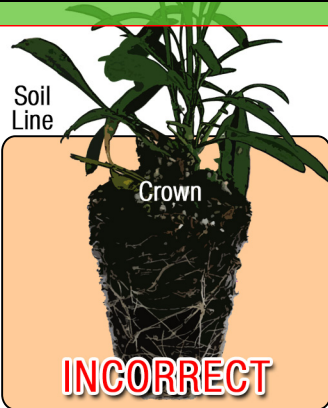
Hardiness Zones: 9 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, mites, white fly and thrips are possible

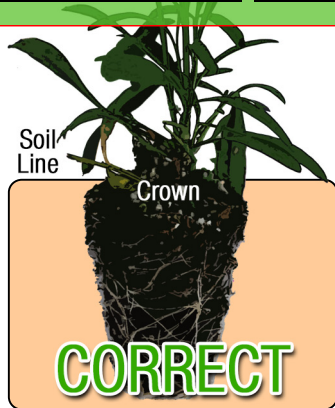
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Rust and powdery mildew are possible

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

## Description

Coreopsis 'Pumpkin Pie' forms a low growing mound with numerous red-eyed, pumpkin-orange flowers. Very free-flowering, blooms from early summer to fall. Pumpkin Pie is good for three seasons - it's not just for fall anymore. Great in containers, mixed beds, or borders.
