

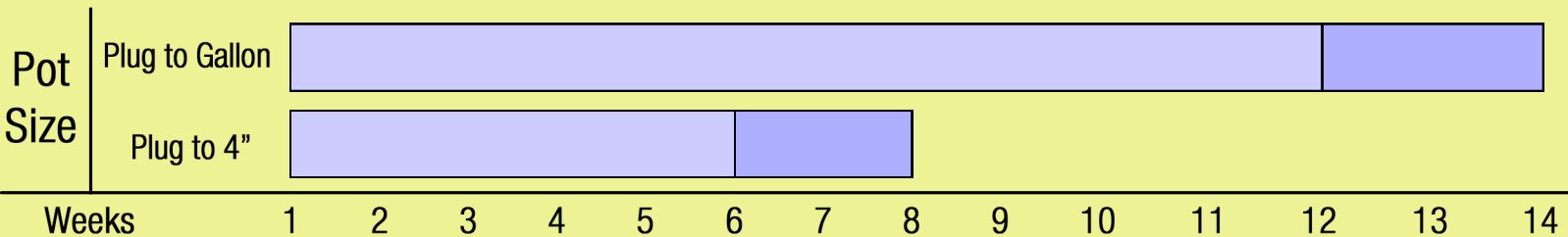

# ECHINACEA 'CHIQUITA'

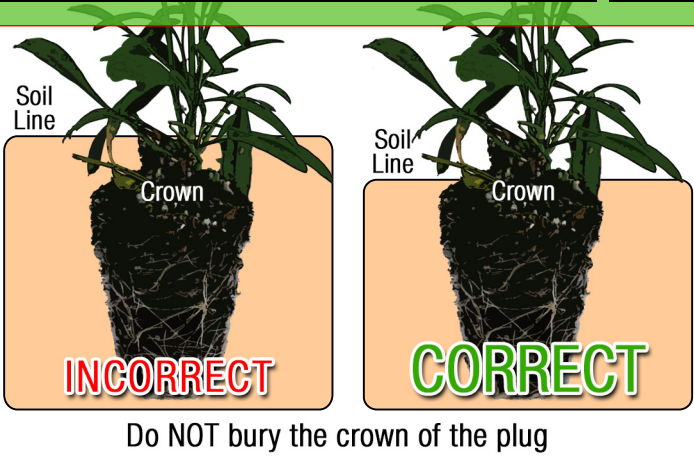
## PRAIRIE PIXIE™ SERIES

pH: 5.8 - 7.3	Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM	EC: 0.7
Light Levels: Full sun	Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs	
Habit: Clumping	<u>Diseases</u> : The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist	
Day Length for Flowering: Long day

A naturally short habit, high crown count, very large flowers for a dwarf and a lovely, soft yellow color. No other Echinacea has this color or habit. As a container plant, 'Chiquita' is a star performer and in the garden, nothing could light up a tight space like this fragrant, easy to grow gem.
