

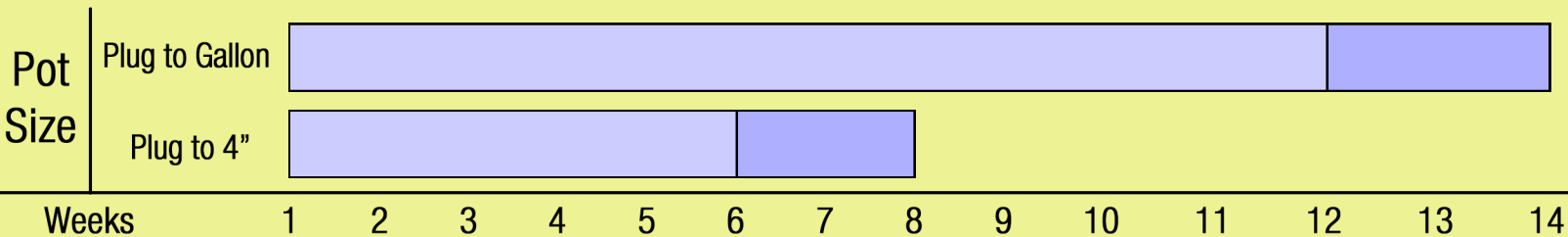

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

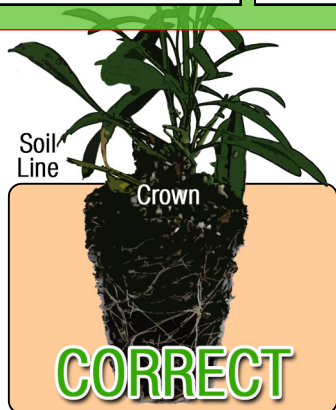
Habit: Clumping

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Lovely double red anemone-type flowers shoot upward from an upright, well-branched plant. Blooming heavily from summer until frost here in Oregon, we have found these equally at home in containers or in the border, finding them particularly useful in front of grasses to cover ungainly "feet".
