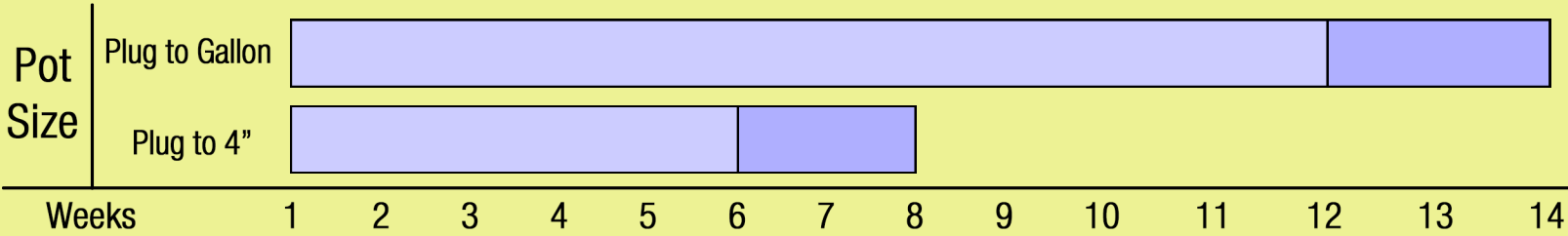


Growing Recipe

ECHINACEA 'ROSITA'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

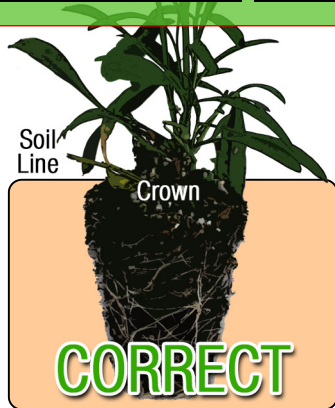
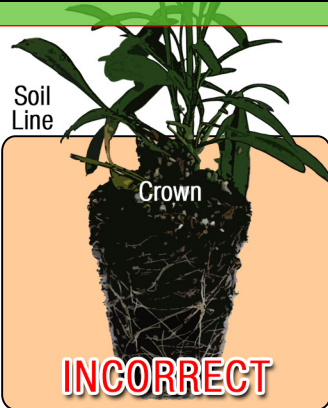
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

'Rosita' is 'Chiquita's' sister in habit and bloom count, but has light pink flowers that have a showy center cone and reflexing petals. Another super garden plant with a fantastic habit.
