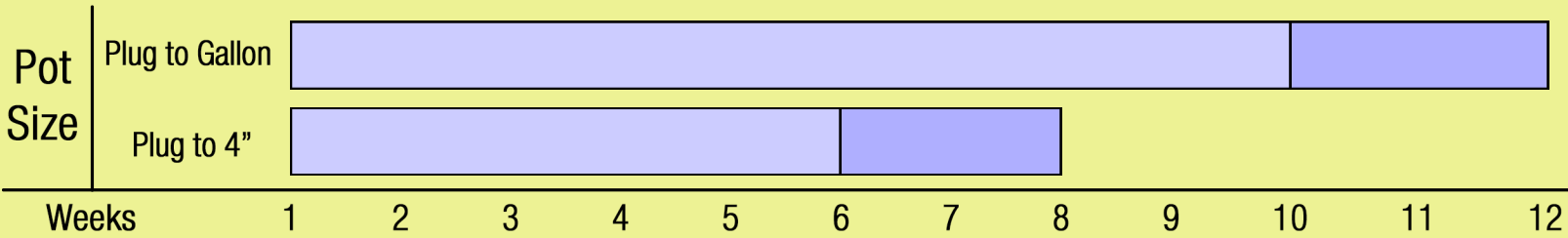


Growing Recipe

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 1.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

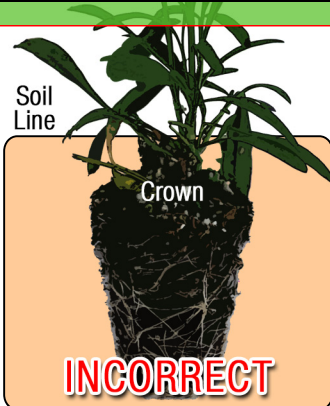
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 8

Possible Problems: Insect: No major, mites and aphids could be a problem

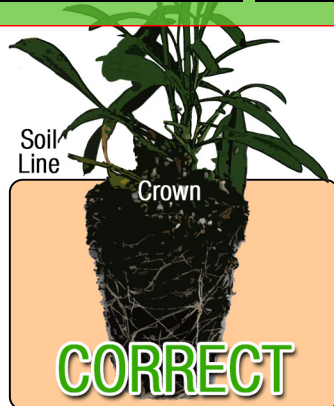
Habit: Upright clumper

Diseases: No major problems

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Sometimes a garden needs a plant that is just fun! This dwarf variegated Eupatorium plays well with others in containers and in the garden. Filled, feather-like foliage is emerald green, lined and edged with soft cream and kissed with pink and rose. Tiny, lavender pink flowers come mid-summer and make butterflies very happy!
