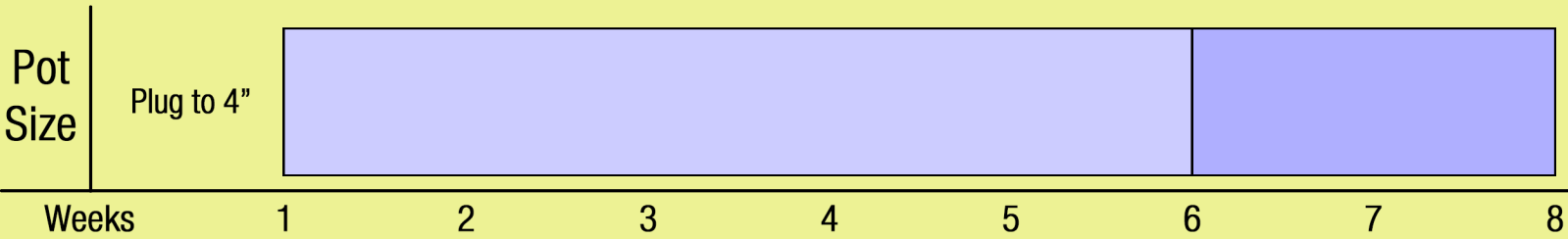


# Growing Recipe

# EUPHORBIA 'ROYAL VELVET'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 6.5 - 7.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 0.7 - 1.0

Light Levels: Sun

Water Requirements: Dry completely between waterings

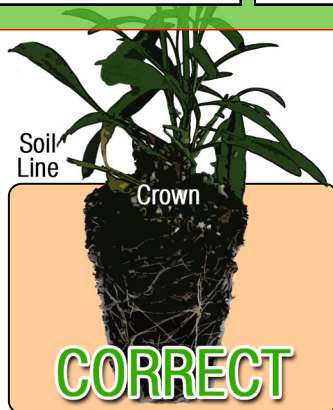
Hardiness Zones: 7 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Mites and root rots can be an issue

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Root rot can be an issue

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug

## Description

Tailored evergreen velveteen leaves of rich deep red provide the perfect foil for its spring floral display. In spring, its 8" chartreuse-colored flower spikes have dramatic dark maroon eyes. This cross between *E. characias* 'Portuguese Velvet' and *E. x martinii* 'Red Martin' has the best of both worlds! Requires good drainage.
