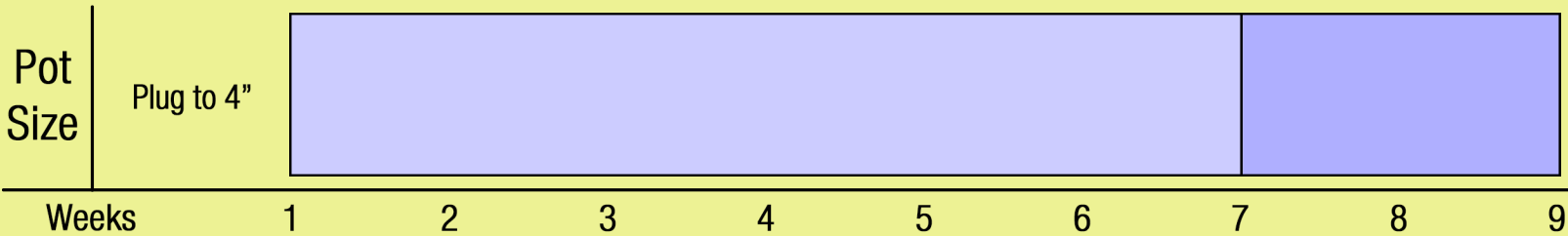

pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: --

Light Levels: Part shade

Water Requirements: Moist to dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 7 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Mites and whitefly can be a problem

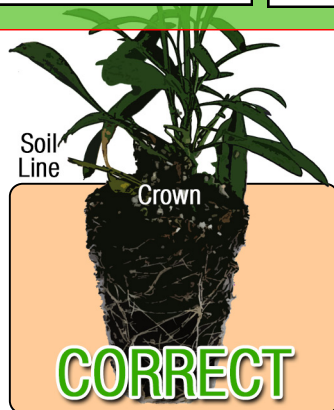
Habit: Mounding
