

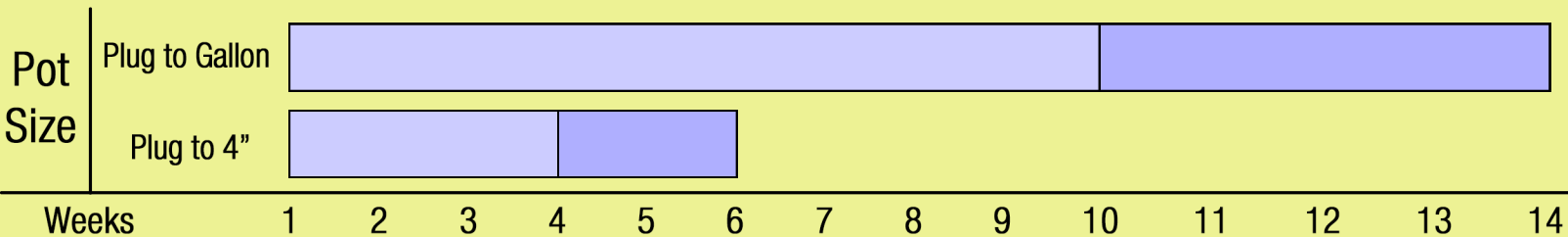


Growing Recipe

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

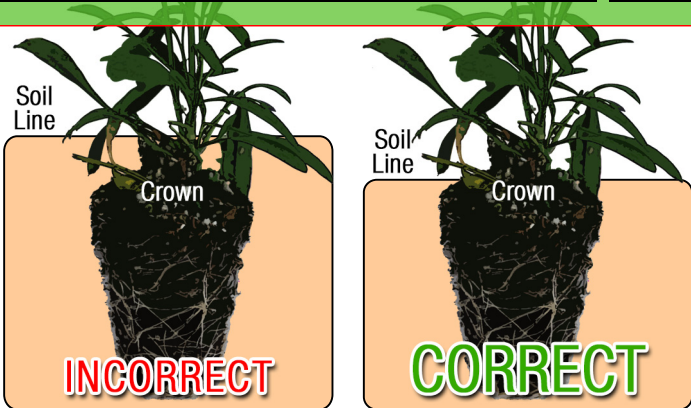
 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.0	Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 200 PPM	EC: 0.5 - 2.0
Light Levels: Morning sun to part shade	Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 6 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Mites are possible	
Habit: Grass with short creeping rhizomes	<u>Diseases</u> : The plant can get crown rot if the soil is kept too wet	
Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral
