

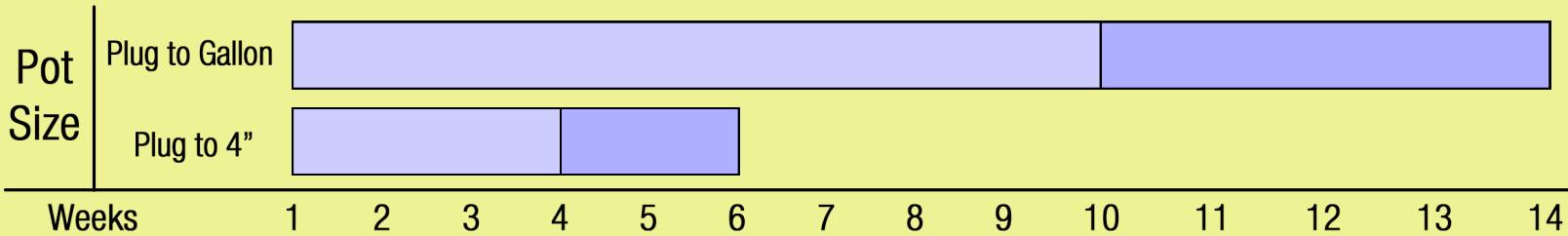


Growing Recipe

HAKONECHLOA MACRA

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 2.0

Light Levels: Morning sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

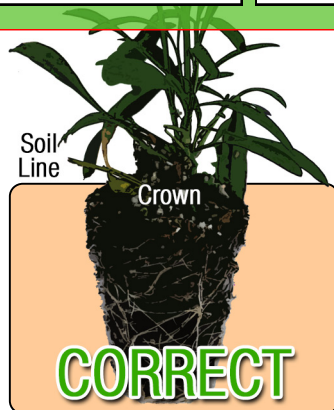
Hardiness Zones: 6 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Mites are possible

Habit: Grass with short creeping rhizomes

Diseases: The plant can get crown rot if the soil is kept too wet

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Surprisingly, this form of (haw-koh-nay-clo-ah) is harder to find than the variegated forms! THE grass for shady locations, this Japanese gem is outstanding between Hosta. They lend peace and grace to streambeds or along pathways in the shade garden. We grow it in the Pacific Northwest in full sun as well. Nice in containers too.
