



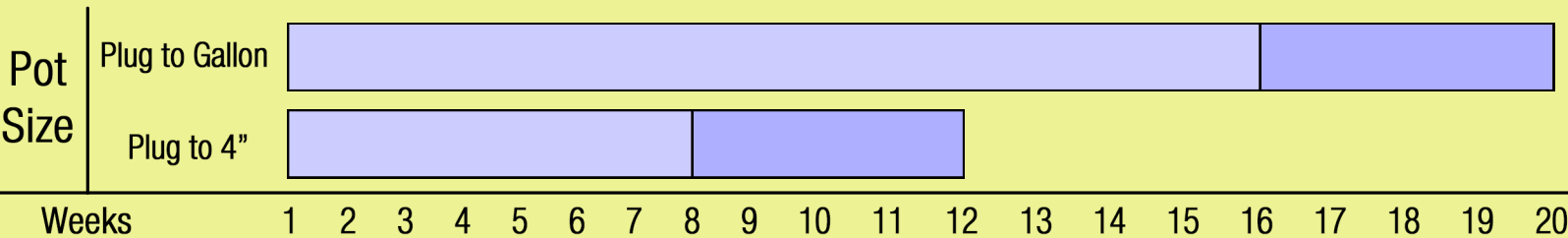

# HELLEBORUS NORTH STAR™ 'PLUM'

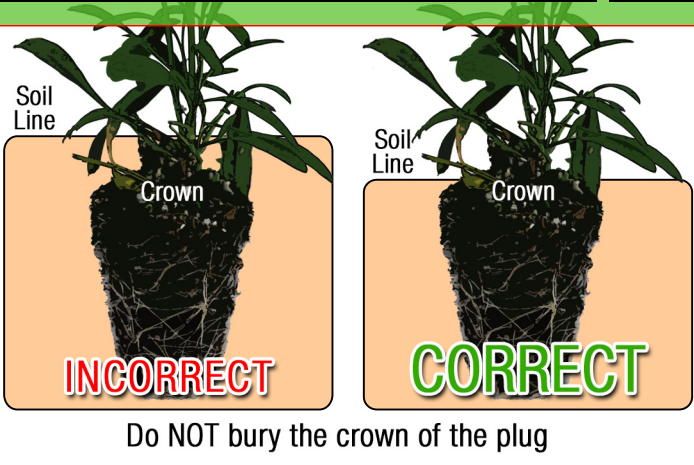

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 6.0 - 7.0	Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM	EC: 1.5 - 2.0
Light Levels: Sun to shade	Water Requirements: Keep moist. Do not allow to dry out between waterings.	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Aphids are possible	
Habit: Clumping	<u>Diseases</u> : Black rot is possible if poor drainage	
Day Length for Flowering: Short day		



## Description

Stunningly rich, plum-purple double flowers are held just above the pine-green foliage. This evergreen, deer-resistant plant adds dramatic color to sunny borders and tree understories as late winter turns to spring. Bred for reliable tissue culture production planning. Plant in spring for flowering the following winter.
