

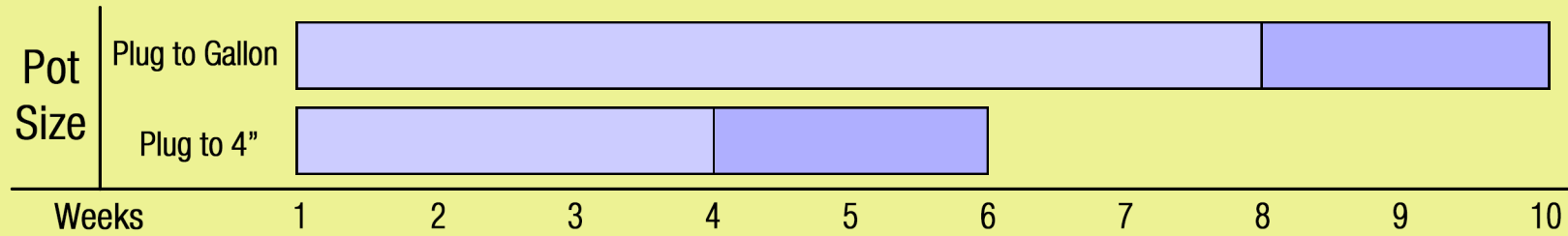


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'BLOOD RED'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

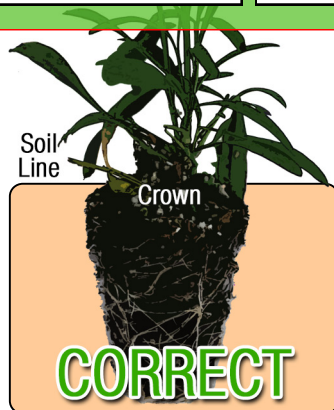
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

Large, blood red flowers on 20" stalks erupt over bright green leaves swirled with a silvery-white overlay. Largest red flower yet. Some variegation is common on the small compact foliage. Great in the rock garden, border, and one of the best for container production!
