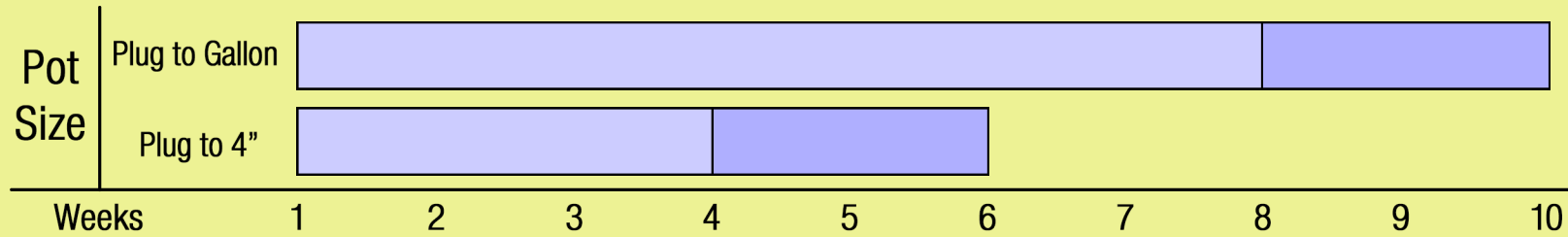


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'CHAMPAGNE'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

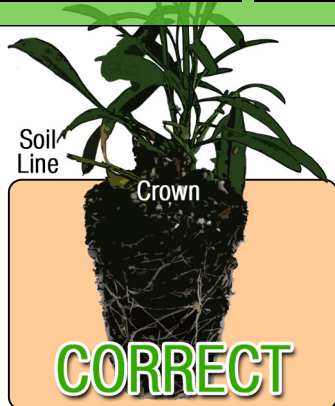
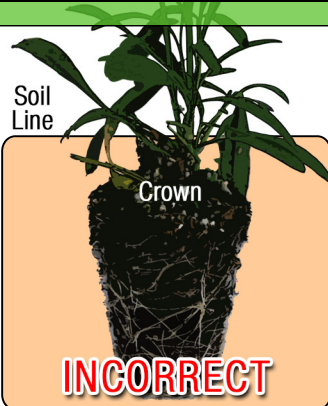
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. Rust and botrytis may occur in high humidity environments.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug

Description

This is a stunning plant with medium size leaves changing from peach to gold to champagne-gold with a strong white veil overall. Free-flowering maroon stems with light peach flowers most of the season.
