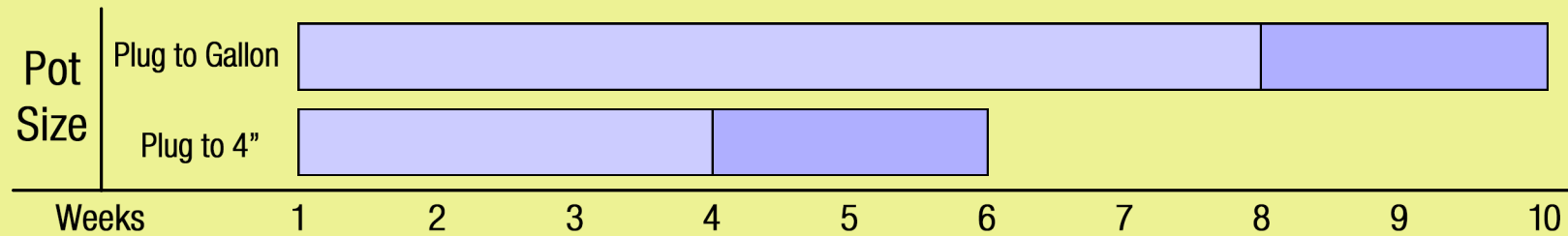


# Growing Recipe

# HEUCHERA 'CREOLE NIGHTS'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

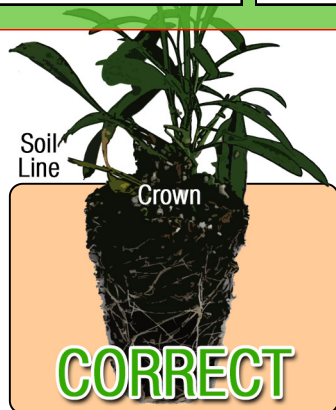
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



## Description

A great landscape plant with large, glossy almost black leaves in a clean, dense mound. Short stems of white flowers help keep up the clean, shiny appearance. Bigger leaves and a larger habit than 'Obsidian'. Use in borders, mixed beds, and containers for accent or contrast.
