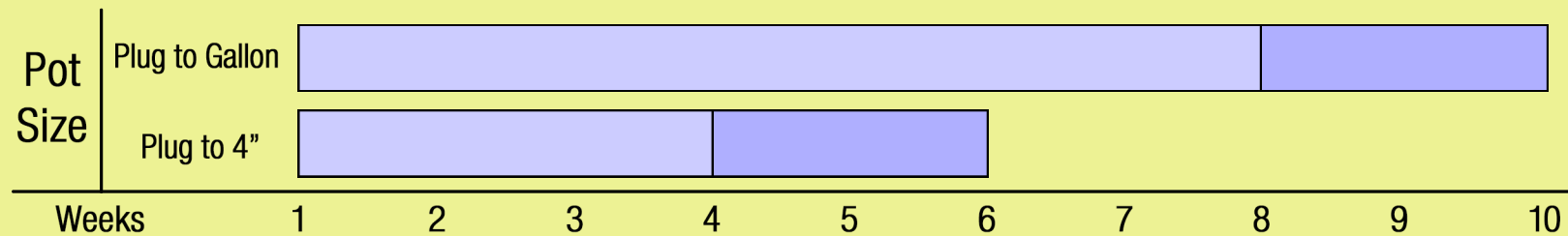


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'FIRE ALARM'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

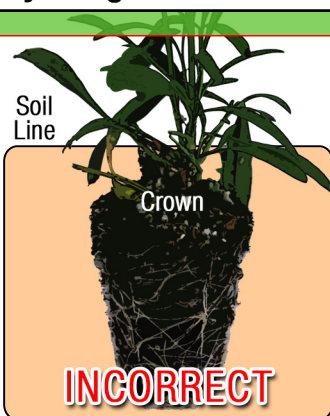
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

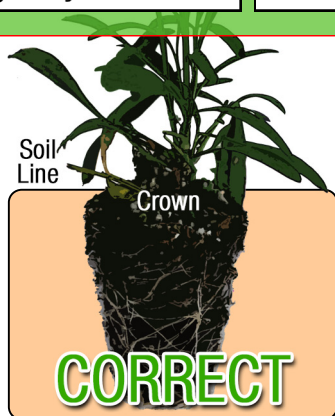
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture

Day Length for Flowering: Day Neutral

Description

Bigger and brighter than 'Fire Chief' or 'Autumn Leaves', 'Fire Alarm' is bright red in spring and fall and darkens to a brown-red during the summer. This hybrid of *H. villosa* has thick, leathery red, red leaves that make delightful medium size mound. 'Fire Alarm' complements almost every section of the color palette, but it can stand on its own without question. Won the Silver medal at Plantarium 2014 and best Heuchera in the Shade in Ohio State trials, 2012.
