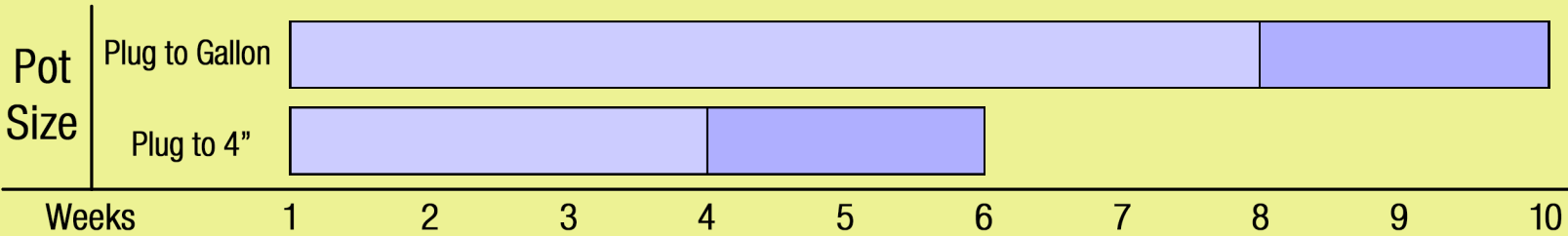


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'GYPSY DANCER'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

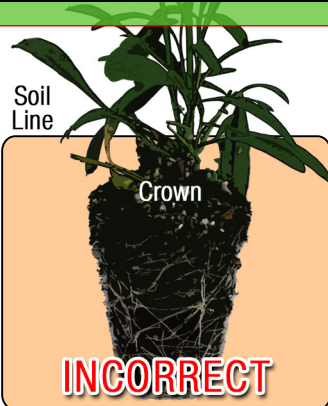
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

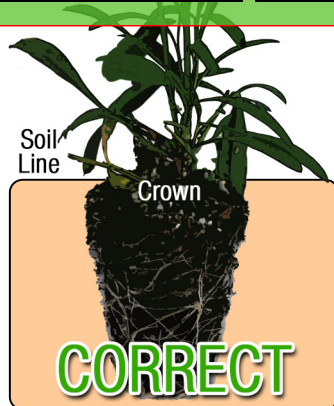
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

This floriferous hybrid has a multitude of light pink flowers swirling over low, and flashy metallic silver and gray foliage. A heavy repeat bloomer which is first to start and last to finish! Stays small and flashy. Doesn't require long cold treatments to bloom like most Heuchera making it great for the South. Will grow in heavier shade than many others, but can also thrive in full sun.
