

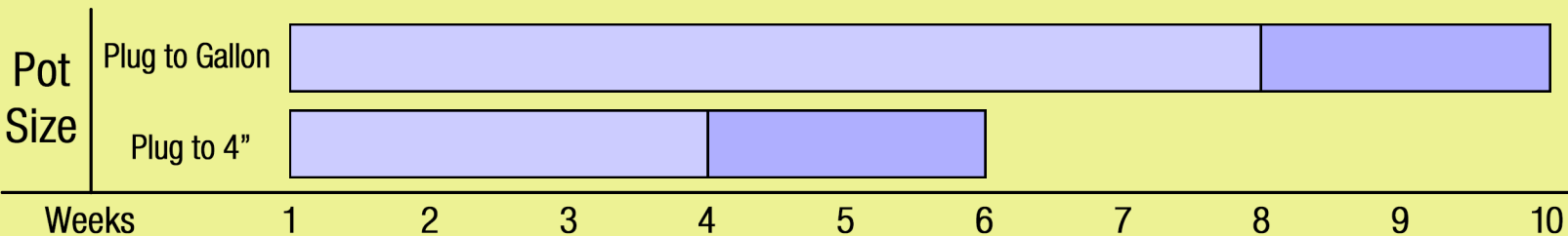


# Growing Recipe

# HEUCHERA 'MIDNIGHT BAYOU'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

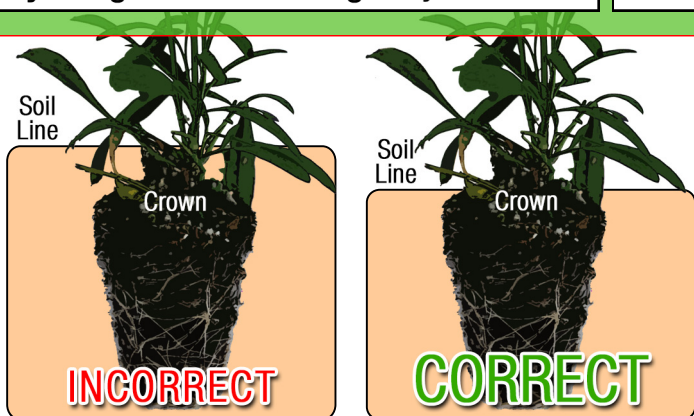
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

## Description

Large maple-like leaves of purple with black veins and light pink-flowers. The leaf color changes with the season from red purple to silvered purple. The *H. villosa* heritage adds to the appeal of this bayou-beauty.
