

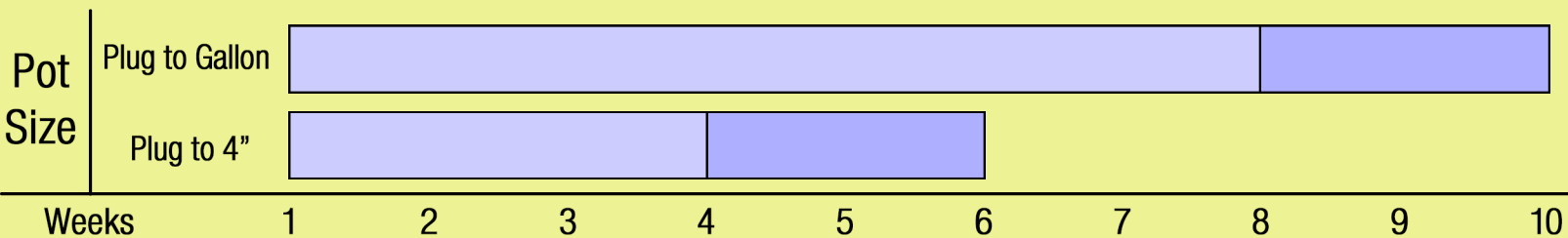


# Growing Recipe

# HEUCHERA 'MIDNIGHT ROSE'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

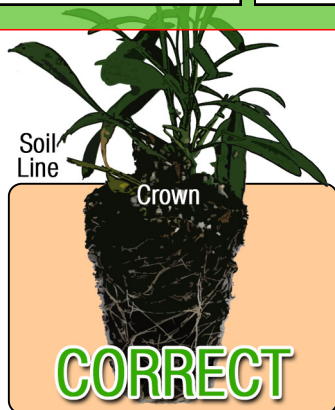
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

This award winning plant has shiny, pink-spotted black leaves and a vigorous rounded habit. It's a sport of 'Obsidian' that was discovered at Behnke Nursery in MD. Pink spotted leaves enlarge and brighten before lightening to cream as the season progresses. Bold, black, and beautiful for sunny locations. Does well... everywhere!
