

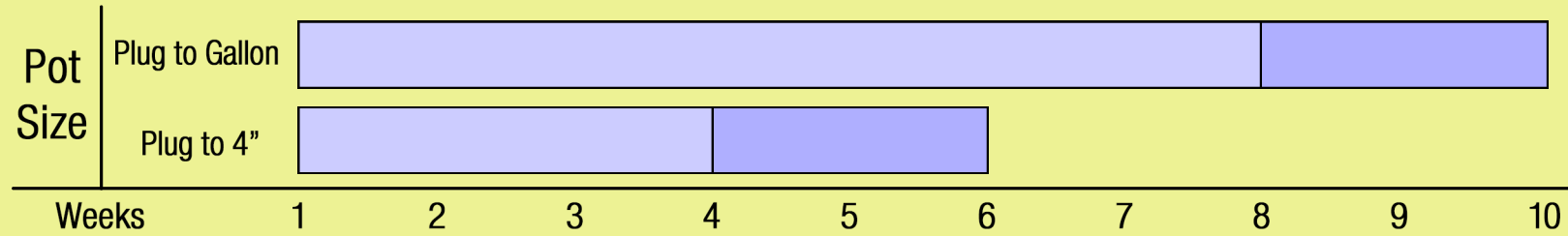


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'PEACH MELBA'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Part shade to shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

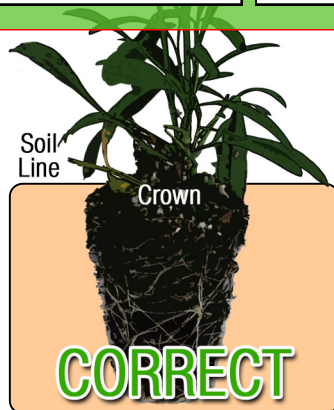
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. Rust and botrytis may occur in high humidity environments.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

A vigorous, clump-forming coral bells cultivar that features peach-orange foliage and creamy pink flowers. The lobed, rounded leaves form a basal mound. Plant leaves vary in color from peach to orange to rust with the hues and shadings changing with the seasons. Tiny, creamy pink flowers appear in spires in late spring on slender red stems rising above the foliage mound to 16" tall.
