

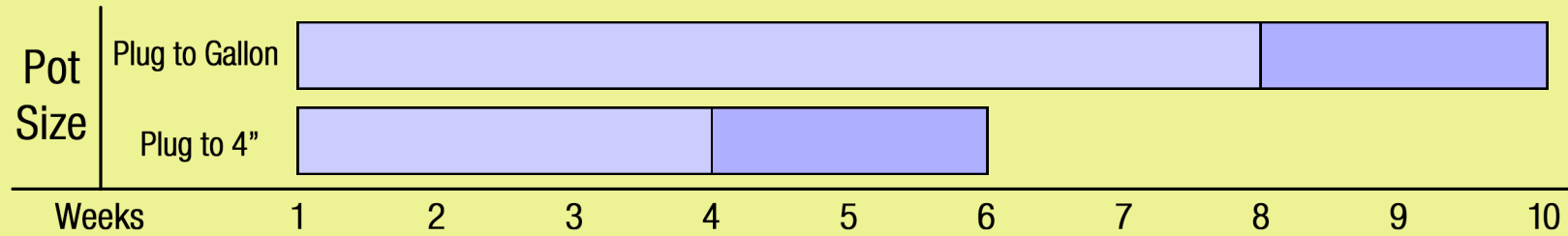


# Growing Recipe

# HEUCHERA 'SUGAR PLUM'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

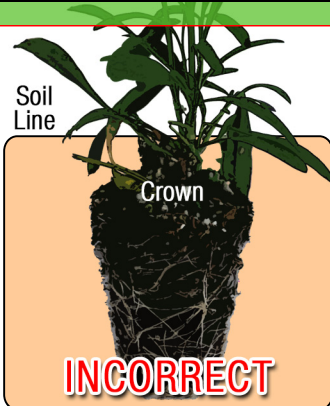
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

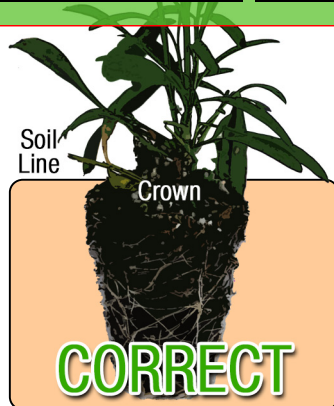
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



## Description

Frosty plum-purple leaves in spring and fall make a full mound of evergreen foliage. Silvery-pink flower spike rise 26 inches above the soil and the plant frequently reblooms. Foliage is silver in summer and winter. H. villosa breeding gives it the bigger habit.
