

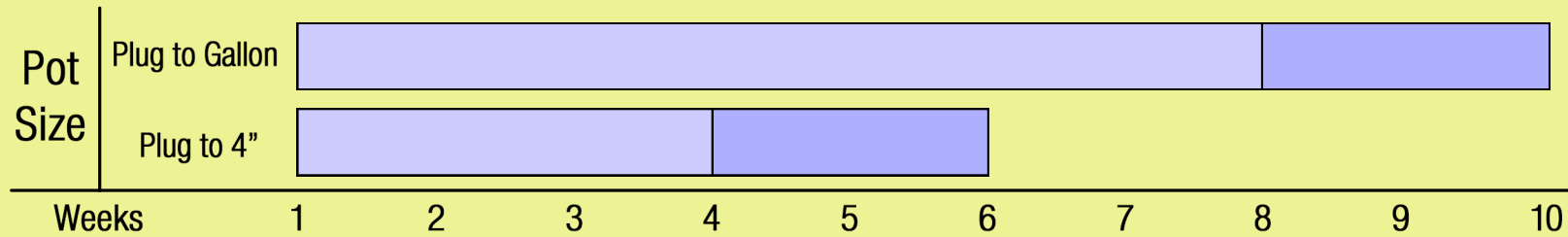


# Growing Recipe

# HEUCHERA 'ZIPPER'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas

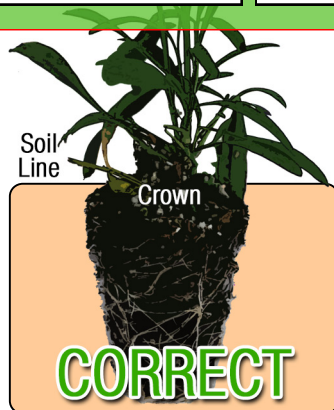
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



## Description

You will love this plant with its brightly colored, seriously ruffled leaves. 'Zipper' leaves are well-colored all year and change from orange in spring and fall to golden amber in summer and winter, always with its magenta backs showing. This ruffle was bred with *H. villosa* which gives the larger leaf size, better heat and humidity tolerance. The ruffle breeding gives the good cold tolerance.
