

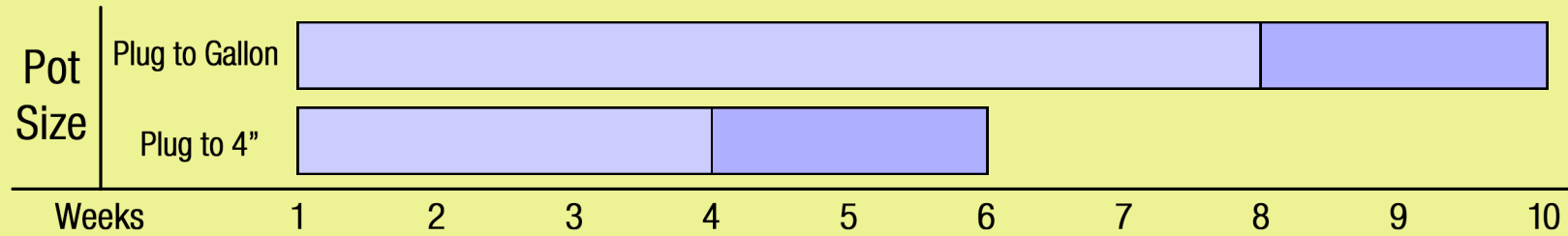


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERELLA 'FIRE FROST'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

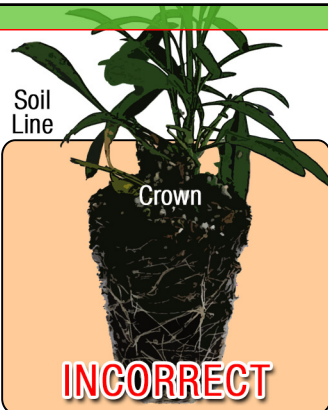
Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

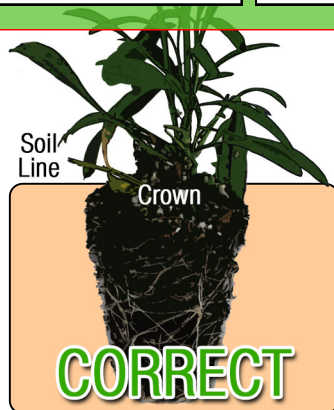
Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils.
Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. **Note**: All Heucherella are rust resistant.

Habit: Mounding

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

Lovely, warm leaves of yellow to lime with a large red center frosted by a strong white veil. It forms a vigorous mound that is well-colored all year. Breeding with *H. villosa* hybrids has given it the larger leaves and habit as well as a tolerance to heat and humidity. Great in a container or in the garden bed.
