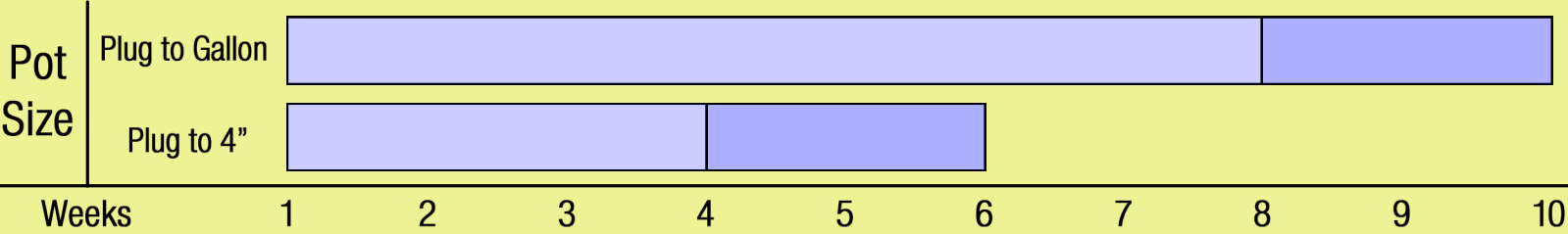

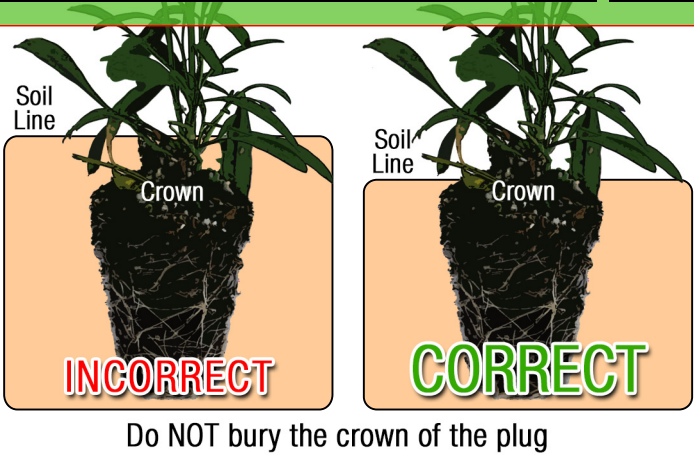
HEUCHERELLA 'PEACH TEA'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5	Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM	EC: 0.6 - 0.9
Light Levels: Full sun to part shade	Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils. <u>Diseases</u> : Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. Note : All Heucherella are rust resistant.	
Habit: Mounding

Large, peachy-red leaves contrast beautifully with cream white flowers. This plant is vigorous and compact but gives off a glow of daintiness in the landscape. Keep your borders clean with 'Peach Tea' or use in containers, summer borders, and mass planting.
