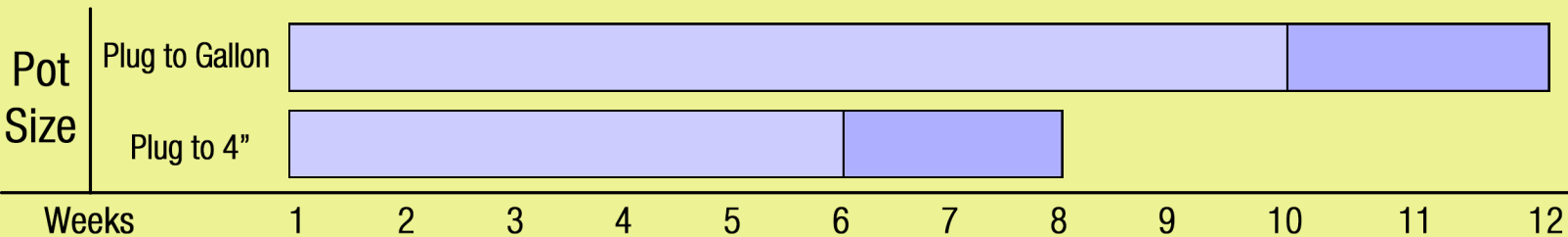


Growing Recipe

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM (Weekly)

EC: 1.0 - 1.2

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between watering

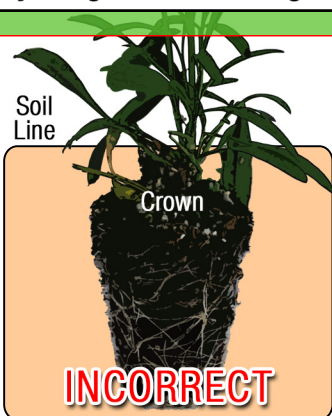
Hardiness Zones: 5 - 8

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids and slugs are possible problems

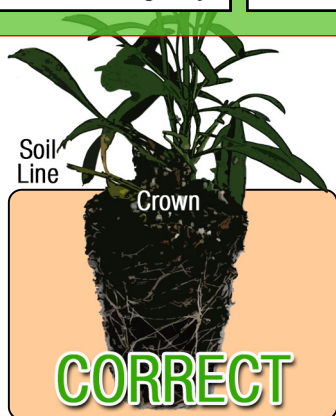
Habit: Clumping

Diseases: No major diseases

Day Length for Flowering: Facultative Long Day

Description

Proves the moon is out! Showy, pom-poms of double flowers rest atop a dense, upright, mound of foliage. Flowers bloom yellow, then gradually change to a two-toned yellow and finally finish white. Flowers stay yellow for two weeks or longer in Oregon, unlike other "yellows" that fade in a matter of days. Use in mixed beds and mass plantings.
