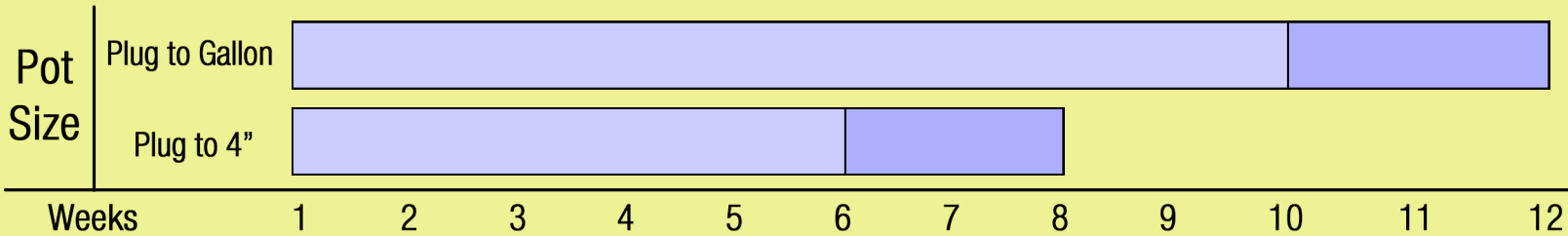


Growing Recipe

LEUCANTHEMUM 'MT. HOOD'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM (Weekly)

EC: 1.0 - 1.2

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between watering

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids and slugs are possible problems

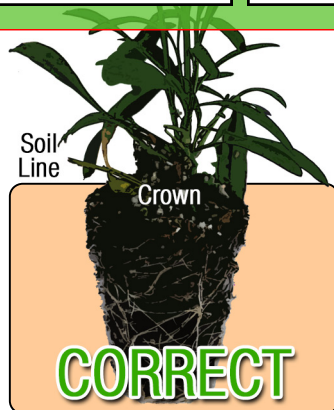
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: No major diseases

Day Length for Flowering: Facultative Long Day

Description

Large, 4"+ double flowers composed of ice crystal like petals. 'Mount Hood' has a perfect mounding habit and an enormous number of flowers throughout the season. Strong rebloom and overall great vigor. Each layer covers the previous bloom cycle. Multiple layers of blooms extend the season. Good foliage cover too! Destined to become a garden classic.
