

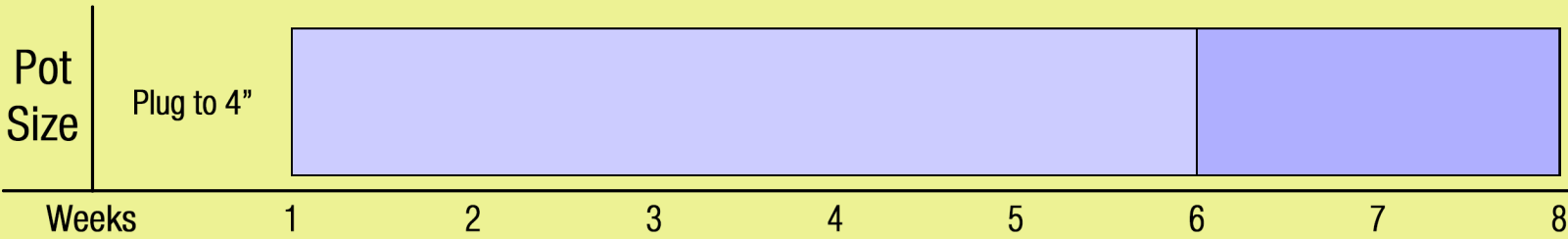


Growing Recipe

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.0 - 7.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

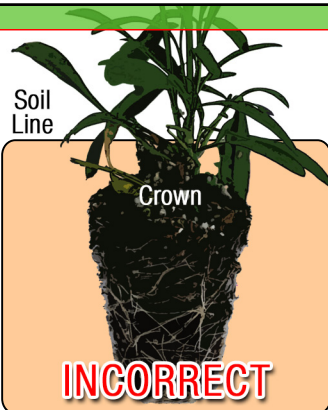
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 8

Possible Problems: Insect: White fly, mites, aphids, and thrips are possible

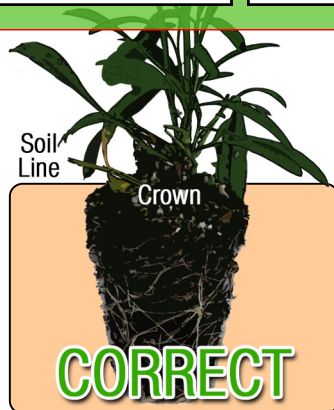
Habit: Clumping

Diseases: No major problems

Day Length for Flowering: Short Day

Displays the same charming blooms of 'Henry Eilers', but it is one third shorter! Still good for cut flowers, but now fits well into the average landscape. This narrow, upright grower makes a great specimen in the border. The very appealing quilled, gold flowers bloom summer until frost.
