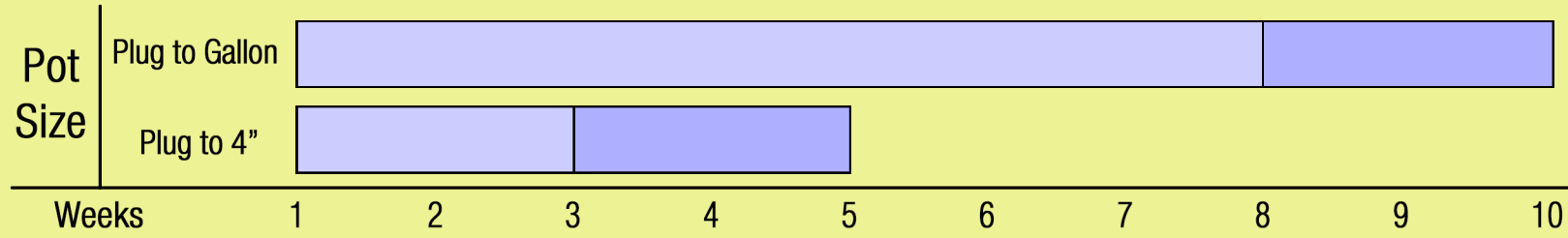

pH: 5.5 - 7.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun

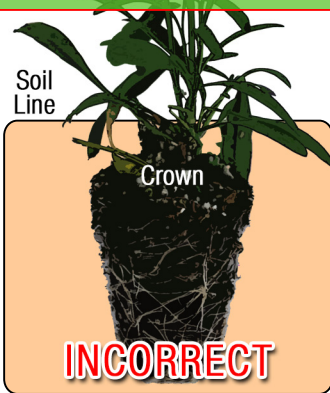
Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 10

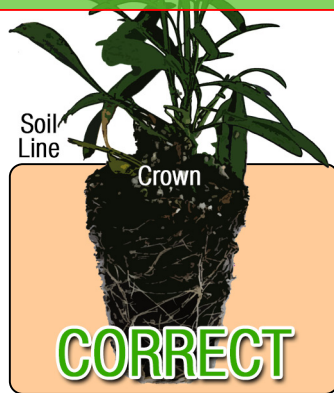
Possible Problems: Insect: None seen  
Diseases: Root rots could be a problem with poor drainage

Habit: Bushy

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

This one has it all. It flowers continuously from June until frost with deep red "bird like" flowers, giving it the common name "Red Birds in a Tree". In addition CARDINALE™ Red has leaves that are a fresh green color, a short, bushy habit, and the hummingbirds love it. Drought tolerant once established. A new version of the high elevation New Mexico native.
