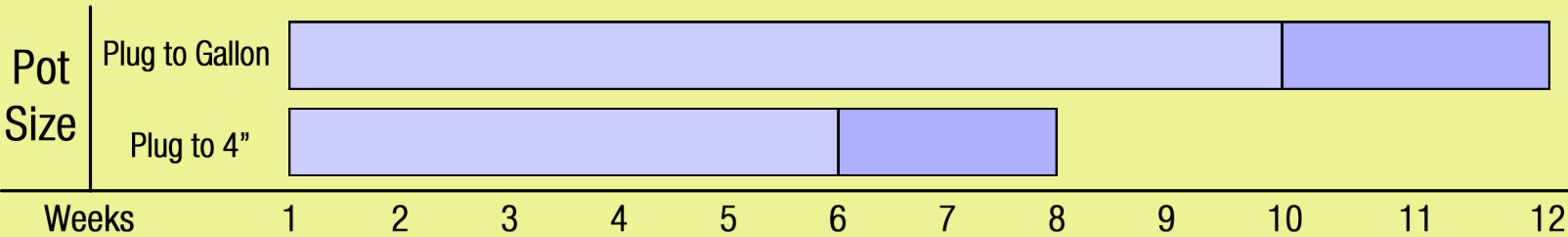

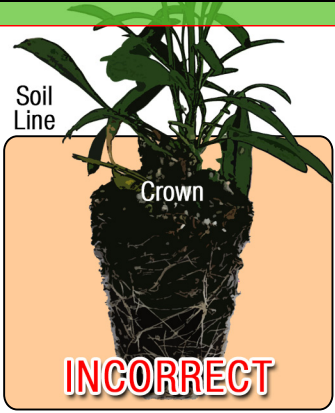
TIARELLA 'JEEPERS CREEPERS'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

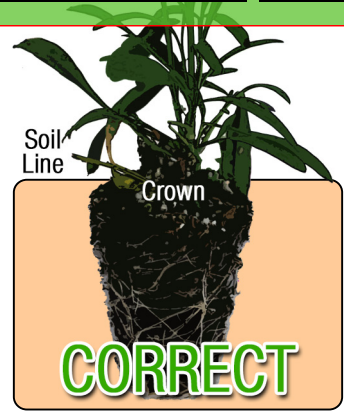
☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8	Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM	EC: 0.6 - 0.9
Light Levels: Shade to part shade	Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Root weevil in the garden	
Habit: Groundcover	<u>Diseases</u> : Can be affected by root rots if soil is kept too wet	
Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Bold, well-marked foliage, a creeping (not running) habit and large white flowers. If you don't want your trailing Tiarella to run too far this one is for you. It keeps some green all winter in Oregon rather than getting dark for excellent winter interest. Excellent vigor.
