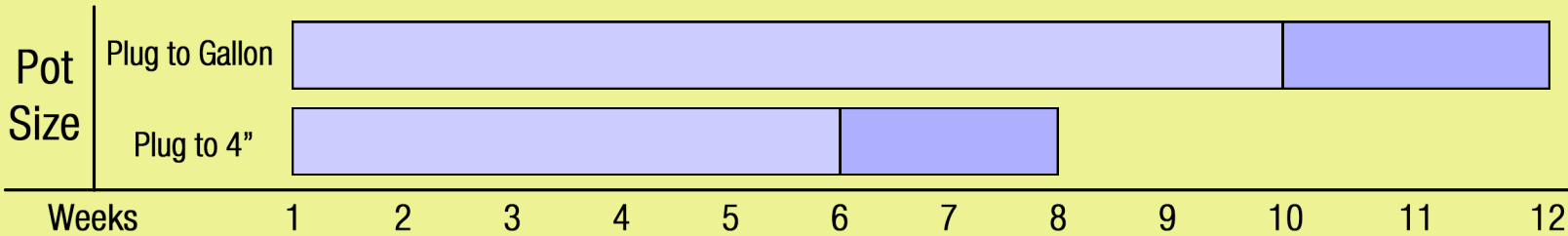


Growing Recipe

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Part or full shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

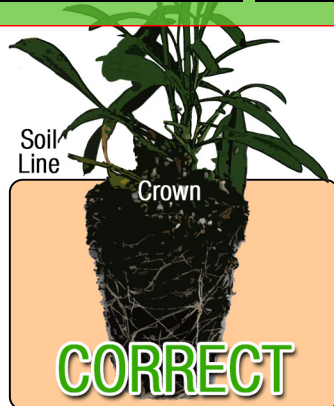
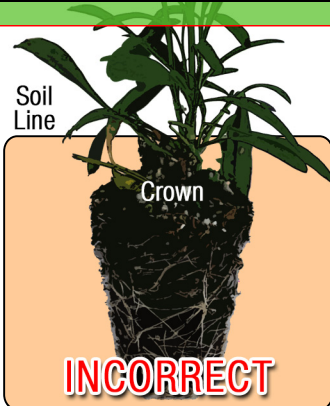
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevil in the garden

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Can be affected by root rots if soil is kept too wet

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug

Description

Deeply cut, star-shaped green leaves with burgundy coloration along veins form a tidy clump in the early spring. While the foliage could stand alone, delicate pink flowers steal the show when they emerge in spring. Excellent low-maintenance plant.
