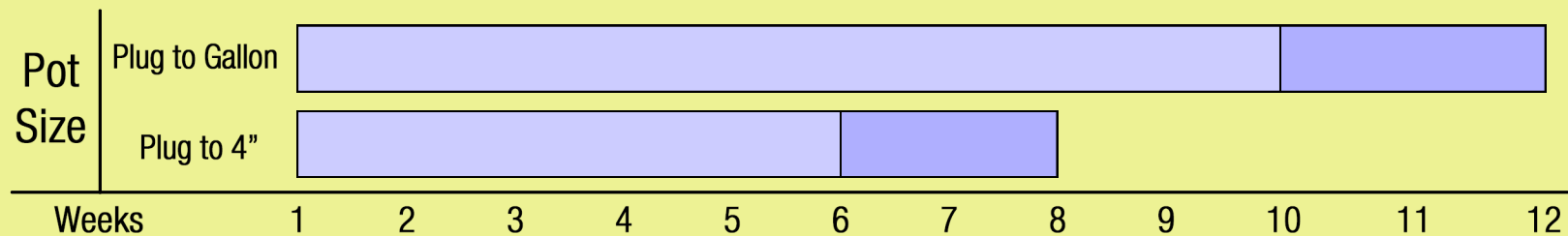


Growing Recipe

TIARELLA 'PINK BOUQUET'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Part or full shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

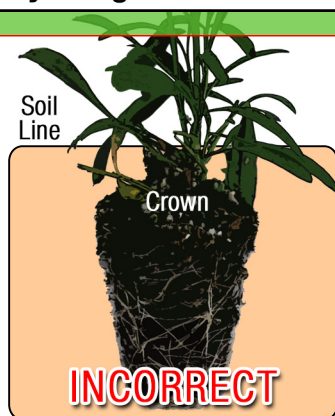
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevil in the garden

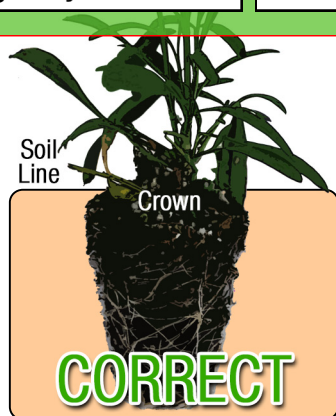
Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Can be affected by root rots if soil is kept too wet

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

This plant is a champion for flower color, form, fragrance and spike density. From internet: " 'Pink Bouquet' forms a restrained compact foot-tall mound of maple-like leaves with a maroon heart. In March it sends up its stems with tiny pink buds that burst open, for April or May, into sprays of pink & white flowers forming little upright pyramids. Rebloom occurs right up to August. The leaves are semi-evergreen through winter, though very beaten up by January or February when a good trim-back to make room for new leaves is advisable even if not necessary."
