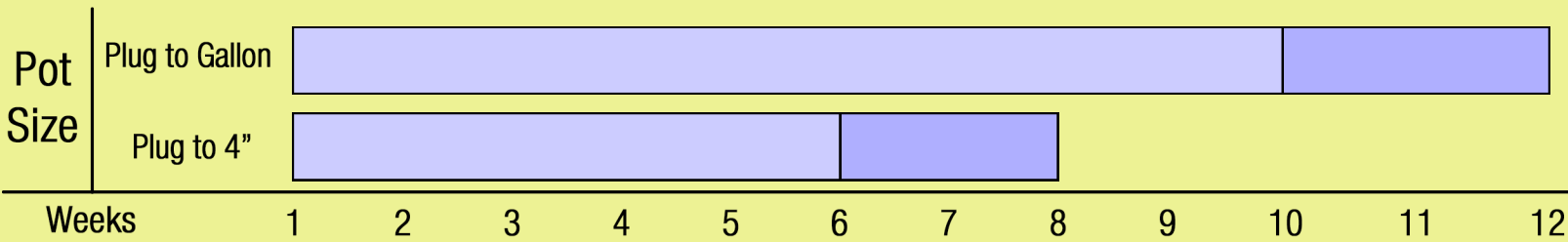


Growing Recipe

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Part or full shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

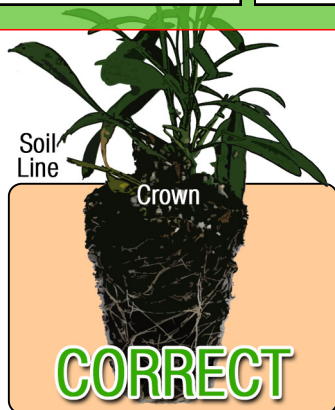
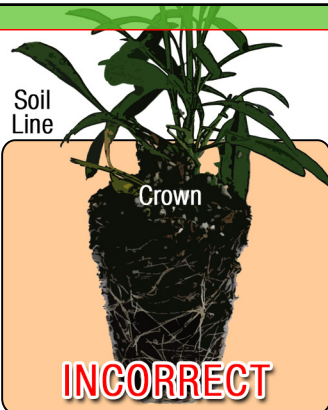
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevil in the garden

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Can be affected by root rots if soil is kept too wet

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug

Description

Has leaves that resemble an ornate baroque Spanish cross and form the base for this strong clumping foamflower. Blooms are pink. Humidity resistant. Nice bronzing in winter.
