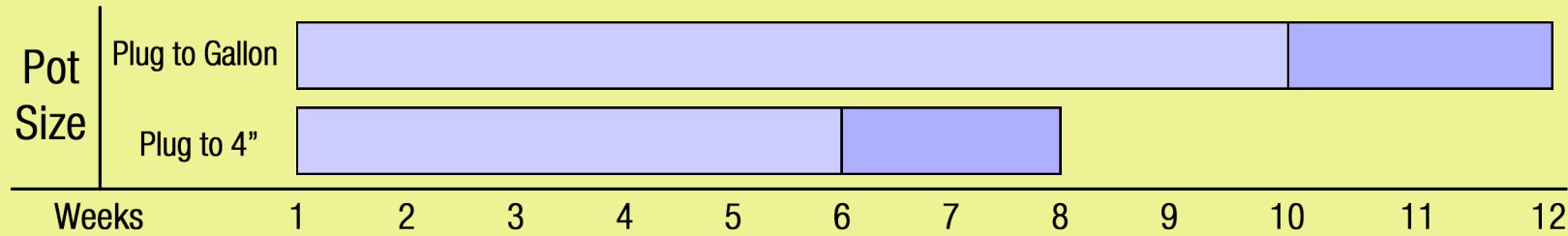

pH: 5.8 - 7.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.75 - 1.25

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

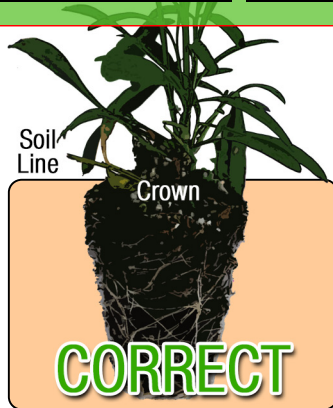
Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Brilliant gold foliage spreads in dense mats and is complemented by rich blue flowers in May. This versatile groundcover works well in mixed containers, hanging baskets, over walls, etc. Great to contrast with our top selling black leaved Heuchera 'Obsidian'.
